There is a lot of information that we will ask you to provide to our office in order to work effectively as your attorney. You will gain the most benefit from your initial appointment if you can bring the following information with you.

- 1. Confidential Dissolution/Modification Questionnaire.
- 2. Your completed Uniform Support Affidavit.
- 3. Copies of your most recently filed State and Federal Tax return.
- 4. Copies of both parties' last 4 pays stubs.
- 5. A list of your assets and debts.
- 6. Copy of the deed to your residence.
- 7. Copies of vehicle registrations and/or titles.
- 8. Any court documents that may have been served upon you.
- 9. Copies of any previous Judgment, Parenting Plan or Modification.
- 10. A picture of you and your spouse.
